Call for Nominations

Nominations are due Friday, October 9th, 2009 for the 6th Annual Saskatchewan Lieutenant Governor's Greenwing Conservation Award to recognize individuals and groups who strive to preserve and protect Saskatchewan wetlands.

Awarded annually and sponsored by Ducks Unlimited Canada, the Saskatchewan Lieutenant Governor's Greenwing Conservation Award is presented to an individual, company or organization from Saskatchewan who has demonstrated:

- Leadership in a project or activity that has contributed significantly to the public awareness of the value of conservation of wetlands.
- Outstanding volunteer service to assist an organization or community-based program or project, which benefits wetland conservation.
- Leadership in an education project or activity, which has increased the public's awareness and understanding of the values of wetland ecosystems to Saskatchewan and their benefit to waterfowl, wildlife and people.
