Born in Toronto, Robert Bateman has been a talented and devoted artist and naturalist since his childhood.

Today, Bateman is one of the world's most highly acclaimed artists depicting the natural world. Throughout his career, Bateman has had numerous sell-out exhibitions in Canada, the U.S. and Great Britain. His work is in many public and private collections, including several art museums.

Bateman has a long list of honours, awards and honorary doctorates. One of his most notable achievements was being named Officer of the Order of Canada – the country's highest civilian award.

Bateman's painting *George River Caribou* was selected to join Ducks Unlimited Canada's 2010 Art Portfolio. This limited edition series is available only through DUC fundraising initiatives. The money raised through this program supports DUC's on-the-ground wetland conservation work, scientific research and education programs.
