Foxes appear in stories from around the world. They are usually seen as clever troublemakers but perhaps that is simply because they are hunters that need to be able to sneak up on their prey.

The red fox is found across Canada. They dig deep dens with several entrances in which they have their young. The family stays together hunting until the fall when the pups grow up and move out on their own. Foxes eat mice, squirrels and rabbits but also other foods such as insects, crayfish and plants. Just like other animals, foxes have to watch out for a hungry predator, such as a coyote or bobcat, which might look upon them as dinner!






### To make your paper model

You will need: scissors, glue for paper (glue sticks work well)



1.Cut out all pieces.









2. Fold head in three steps as shown above.




3. Cut & glue shoulder darts.



4. Glue tabs together under body.



5. Glue tips of nose and ears together.



6. Glue rump pieces together.



7. Cut slits in tail pieces and glue pieces together along outside edges.



8. Slide tail on to rump and glue in place.
