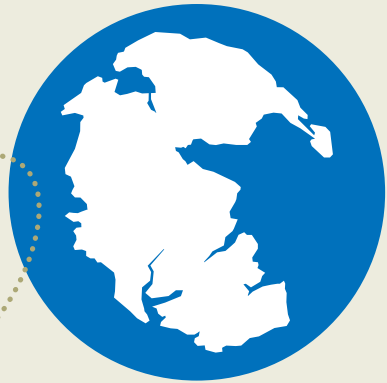


# Dragonflies have (almost) seen it all...

Dragonflies have been around since before the dinosaurs, evolving to survive and bearing witness to many different versions of life on Earth.

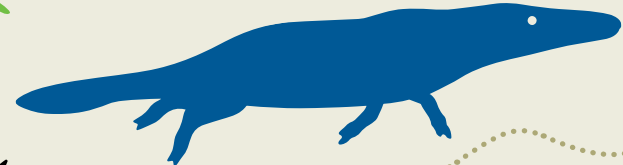


**300 million years ago**

When all land on Earth was one big supercontinent (Pangaea).



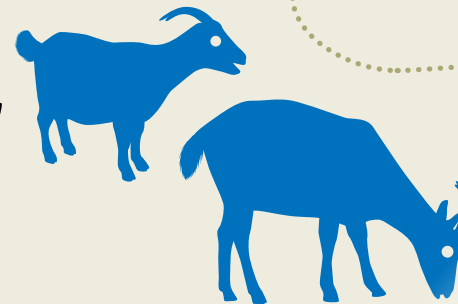
**150 million years ago**  
When pterodactyls shared the skies and dinosaurs roamed the Earth.



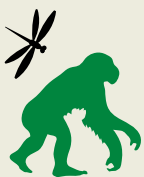
**40 million years ago**
