



Treatment Wetlands: Sustainable Solutions for Road Salt Runoff

THE CHALLENGE: ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS OF WINTER ROAD SALT

Each winter, municipalities face the challenge of keeping roadways safe for drivers, often using road salt and de-icing chemicals to combat snow and ice. While effective at melting snow and ice to improve driving safety, there is growing concern about the environmental tradeoffs as these chemicals run into our rivers and lakes, impacting water quality and wildlife habitat for many species of plants and animals.

The runoff from municipal "snow dumps" can be especially problematic, containing gravel, salt and hydrocarbons from oil and gas, among other things.

THE SOLUTION: CONSTRUCTED WETLANDS

The City of Moncton partnered with Ducks Unlimited Canada (DUC) to build a three-acre (1.6-hectare) constructed wetland, strategically located between a snow dump and a local watercourse. The wetland filters runoff from snowmelt, using salt-resistant plants to remove pollutants like salt, gravel and oil.

RESULTS SHOWED A REDUCTION IN CHLORIDE LEVELS BETWEEN 66-93% "We're pleased with the results we've seen so far. Clearly wetlands and green infrastructure can go a long way towards filtering a lot of the pollutants that get scooped up during snow removal operations. We look forward to applying these and other solutions in the future to help protect the quality of our waterbodies."
