

2027 Ducks Unlimited Canada Manitoba Conservation Calendar Raffle

Rules of Play/Rules and Regulations

1. Ducks Unlimited Canada (DUC) is a national non-profit corporation with a mission to conserve, restore and manage wetlands and associated habitats for waterfowl. These habitats also benefit other fauna, flora and people. Registered charitable organization tax number: 118888957 RR0001
2. This raffle is operated under licence #LGCA 1619-RF-51201 and is subject to the laws of the Province of Manitoba. Tickets are available for purchase in person from authorized Ducks Unlimited Canada volunteers and Ducks Unlimited Canada fundraising staff, or by telephone at 1-800-665-3825, online, or by emailing fundraising@ducks.ca. Purchasers must be at least 18 years old to purchase a calendar/ticket, to have a ticket purchased for them, or to claim a prize. Tickets purchased by, for, or on behalf of anyone under the age of 18 will be disqualified. Government issued photo ID may be required.
3. The raffle title is "2027 Ducks Unlimited Canada Manitoba Conservation Calendar Raffle." Calendar/ticket sales close on December 14, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. CST, unless all calendars are sold prior to that date. All fifty-three (53) draws will be conducted on December 30, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. CST at the Ducks Unlimited Canada office, 1 Snow Goose Bay, Stonewall, MB, R0C 2Z0. Ticket holders may attend the draw in person if they choose.
4. The winner of the \$10,000 cash prize will be announced on December 30, 2026, and will be notified by phone and/or email using the contact information provided. All other draws will be announced weekly on Wednesdays throughout 2027, beginning January 6, 2027, and continuing to December 29, 2027. Winners will be posted at www.ducks.ca/manitobaconservationcalendar/ and Facebook @ducmanitobafundraising and notified by phone and/or email. Purchasers will be entered for a chance to win weekly prizes throughout 2027, with weekly firearm winners choosing between accepting the designated firearm or receiving a \$500 cash prize (CAD), regardless of the firearm's retail value. Prizes will be awarded in the order shown in the calendar.
5. All firearm prizes are classified as nonrestricted long guns under the Criminal Code of Canada. If the designated firearm for a given week is unavailable, DUC reserves the right to award a substitute firearm of similar calibre and equal or greater retail value or allow the winner to select the \$500 cash option (CAD). The total retail value of all prizes is approximately \$99,439 (CAD), which includes the onetime \$10,000 cash prize. Three thousand five hundred (3,500) calendars will be printed. All tickets drawn will be returned to the draw drum and remain eligible for subsequent draws.
6. Firearm models and descriptions are printed on the calendar for each prize week. Images may not precisely represent the actual firearm model. A complete list of raffle prizes and the Rules of Play appear on the back page of the calendar.
7. Each calendar/ticket costs \$50.00. Accepted payment methods include cash, personal cheque, credit card or debit (where available). Returned NSF cheques are subject to a \$40.00 fee and/or disqualification. A calendar will be mailed at no charge, and the ticket will be added to the draw. Entries that are illegible, incomplete, or received after December 14, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. CST may be declared ineligible, and if so the purchaser will not receive a refund.
8. Winners claiming a firearm prize must present a valid Canadian Possession and Acquisition Licence (PAL) within three (3) months of the draw date. POL licences are not accepted. Once the PAL is confirmed through the Canadian Firearms Program, the firearm will be processed for distribution. All firearms are stored and handled through Heights Outdoor and Archery Range in Winnipeg, Manitoba. Winners may pick up their firearm at Heights Outdoor and Archery Range or arrange shipment to the address on file with the Canadian Firearms Program.
9. In the event the winner(s) cannot produce within 12 months a valid, current PAL or POL, they may transfer award of the prize to a direct Family Member aged 18 or older (Child, Spouse, Sibling, Parent, Grandparent only) who is able to produce a valid, current PAL or POL; failure to produce said license within the time period specified, will result in the firearm being returned to Ducks Unlimited Canada (DUC) for the purpose of future fundraising practices. In the event that a drawn winner is deceased at time of prize announcement, DUC reserves the right to offer the prize to the estate of the deceased - or a representative of the estate - if a valid PAL/POL can be produced by same.
10. The name and information provided on the ticket must match the name and information associated with the PAL at the time the prize is claimed.
11. By purchasing a calendar, entrants consent to DUC using their contact information for raffle administration, winner notification, and posting of winner names as required.
