

Ducks Unlimited Canada Saskatchewan Provincial Council 2027 Conservation Calendar Raffle
Rules of Play/Rules and Regulations

1. Ducks Unlimited Canada (DUC) is a national non-profit corporation with a mission to conserve, restore, and manage wetlands and associated habitats for North American waterfowl. These habitats also benefit other wildlife and people. Registered charitable organization tax number: 118888957 RR0001. All proceeds will remain in Saskatchewan to support Ducks Unlimited Canada's conservation work in the province.
2. This raffle is operated under Licence #: LR26-0027 and is subject to the laws of the Province of Saskatchewan. Persons visiting from out of province may purchase tickets while physically in Saskatchewan. You must be at least 18 years old to purchase a calendar/ticket, to have a calendar/ticket purchased for you, or to claim a prize. Do not buy tickets for anyone under 18. If we learn that a ticket was purchased by, for, or on behalf of a person under 18, that ticket will be disqualified and is not eligible for prizes. Valid government-issued photo ID may be required.
3. The raffle is titled "Ducks Unlimited Canada Saskatchewan Provincial Council 2027 Conservation Calendar Raffle." Calendar/ticket sales close on December 31, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. CST. All completed ballots must be received at the Ducks Unlimited Canada Saskatoon office no later than January 5, 2027, at 10:00 a.m. CST, when the draws begin. Paid calendars that do not have a completed ballot received by this deadline will be ineligible, and no refunds will be issued.
4. Fifty-two (52) random firearm draws will be conducted, corresponding to one firearm prize each Wednesday throughout 2027. Twelve (12) separate draws for the \$1,000 monthly cash prizes will also be conducted, one on the third Wednesday of each month. All sixty-four (64) draws will take place on January 5, 2027, at 10:00 a.m. CST at the Ducks Unlimited Canada Saskatoon office: Unit 300 – 3530 Millar Avenue, Saskatoon, SK S7P 0B6. Winners will be notified weekly by telephone and/or email beginning January 6, 2027. Weekly winners will be posted online at www.ducks.ca/SaskatchewanFirearmsCalendar and on Facebook at @DUCSASKFUNDRAISING. Monthly cash prize winners will be notified immediately following the third Wednesday announcement each month. Cash payouts will be issued by cheque from DUC.
5. All firearm prizes are classified as non-restricted long guns under the Criminal Code of Canada.
 - Total retail value of all firearm prizes is \$89,439.00
 - Total value of cash prizes is \$12,000 (CAD).
 - Total prize value of all prizes is \$101,439.00

If the designated firearm for a given week is unavailable, DUC reserves the right to award a substitute firearm of similar calibre and of equal or greater retail value.

A total of four thousand (4,000) calendars will be printed and available for sale. After each draw, the winning ticket will be returned to the draw drum and remains eligible for all subsequent draws.

6. Firearm models and descriptions are printed on the calendar for each prize week. Images may not precisely represent the actual firearm model. A complete list of raffle prizes and the Rules of Play appear on the back page of the calendar.
7. Each calendar/ticket costs \$50.00. Accepted payment methods include cash, personal cheque, credit card, or debit (where available). Returned NSF cheques are subject to a \$40.00 fee and/or disqualification. Calendars may be purchased from Saskatchewan DUC volunteers, DUC staff, and at DUC sanctioned- events. Orders may also be placed by telephone at 1-866-252-3825, by email at fundraising@ducks.ca, or online through the Ducks Unlimited Canada website. Telephone and email buyers must provide all information required on the ticket and complete payment by credit card. A calendar will be mailed to the purchaser, and a \$5.00 shipping and handling fee per calendar will be applied. Entries that are illegible, incomplete, or received after January 5, 2027, at 10:00 a.m. CST are ineligible and will not receive refunds.
8. To claim a firearm prize, winners must present a valid and current Canadian Possession and Acquisition Licence (PAL) within twelve (12) months of the winner announcement date. POL licences are not accepted. Licence information will be submitted to Extreme Range Outfitters, 2412 Millar Avenue, Saskatoon, SK S7K 3V2, for processing. Upon confirmation through Extreme Range Outfitters and the Canadian Firearms Program, the firearm will be shipped at no charge to the winner at the address associated with their firearms licence. Winners may alternatively pick up their firearm at Extreme Range Outfitters.
9. Failure to present a valid PAL within twelve (12) months of the winner announcement will result in the firearm being returned to Ducks Unlimited Canada. The prize will then be donated to a charity approved by the Saskatchewan Liquor and Gaming Authority (SLGA). Any unclaimed prizes will be held for twelve (12) months; thereafter, the prize or its cash equivalent will be donated to a charity approved by SLGA.
10. By purchasing a calendar, entrants consent to DUC using their contact information for raffle administration, winner notification, and posting of winner names as required.
