The world's wetlands are disappearing three times faster than forests. But our conservation community is leading the charge to save them.

- Up to 70% of wetlands are gone from southern areas of Canada.
 - In the most populated areas of Canada, up to 95% of wetlands have been lost.
 - Canada is still losing up to 80 acres of wetlands per day.
 - 97 of Canada's 551 wetlandreliant wildlife species are at-risk.

- Canada is home to 25% of the planet's remaining wetlands.
 - ◆ Leading Canada's wetland conservation effort, DUC has already conserved and influenced more than 55 million wetland acres – roughly 17% of Canada's total known wetlands.
 - We're restoring habitat to make up for lost ground, too −3.4 million acres worth to date.
